Our Year 6 classes have been involved in a creative, collaborative exhibition that explores climate change and what matters most to young people within their own communities called Small Worlds: Little Things Make a Big Difference. Their process began by exploring and the work of Mr Doodle and Kev Munday and then experimenting with their own designs. Following discussions about our environment both in school and around our local area children were prompted to think of how our environment could be improved.

Children then worked in pairs to draft their response; their drafts included design elements taken from the work of Mr Doodle and Kev Munday as well as their own messages about our local area. These are some of their pieces in progress.
