### September Opening Term begins for pupils on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2021

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will be aware we have now come out of all restrictions and we will be reverting back to our normal operations from September.

#### **Start times:**

These will be back to pre-pandemic times and are:

Infants: Doors open at 8.40am and close at 8.55am.

Juniors: Doors open at 8.35am and close at 8.45am.

Anyone arriving after these times must go to the admin office based in the junior school.

#### **Entry points:**

Infant children all go in through their outside classroom door.

Year 3 go down the side path round to the back of the school and in through their outside classroom door.

Year 4 and 5 go down the side path and in through the side door.

Year 6 go down the side path, round the back of the school and in through the doors at the bottom of the stairs.

**Please note on the first day of term junior teachers will meet their classes in the playground and show them the route they need to take.**

#### **Finish times:**

Finish time is 3pm for all classes.

Infant and Year 3 to be collected from classroom doors.

Years 4-6 to be collected from the junior playground.

## **PE days:**

The governors and staff have decided to keep the system of the children wearing their PE kit to school on PE days as it saves valuable time and stops items becoming lost. I would like to remind parents that PE days must follow the school PE uniform which is attached to this letter and children will be spoken to if they continue to wear clothes that are not uniform. PE days are as follows:

Year R- Monday and Friday (please note Year R PE does not start until after October half term)

Year 1- Tuesday and Thursday

Year 2- Monday and Wednesday

Year 3- Tuesday and Friday

Year 4- Tuesday and Wednesday

Year 5- Monday and Thursday

Year 6- Thursday and Friday

## **Positive cases:**

The guidance has now changed and is now as follows:

- If a child has symptoms they must remain at home and have a PCR test, if this is then positive they must isolate for 10 days.
- The class will no longer be required to isolate if a member of the class tests positive.
- Staff who have received both vaccinations will no longer be required to isolate if a member of the class or colleague tests positive.
- We are no longer required to inform parents of any positive cases.
- If we have an outbreak (5 or more cases in one class) we will move to our contingency plan which will be on the website next week.
