We have appointed Miss Bradley to teach in Year 3 next year, Miss Bradley is an experienced teacher who is moving from a school in Farnborough and will be attending the move up days after half term to meet her new class. All other teachers will be remaining in the same year groups. We are currently arranging the classes for next year and details will be published in time for the move up days.

Reminders:

Uniform- Our policy can be found on the website. All children need to be in the correct uniform, including footwear, unless this has been agreed with Mrs Mathlin. Children do not need to wear jumpers/t-shirts with logos but they do need to be the correct colour. Leggings are not permitted unless worn under a skirt.

PE kits- Please ensure that the children wear the correct colour PE kit on their PE days. They need to wear plain, dark bottoms, a white t-shirt and a plain, dark hoodie or jumper. Year 6 may wear their leavers' hoodies on PE days only.

Hot weather- With the weather improving please remember to send your child in with a water bottle, sun hat and sun cream. Staff cannot administer sun cream but they can supervise the younger children. Please ensure all items are named.

Bikes/Scooters- Children are welcome to bring their scooters and bikes to school but we do ask that they are not ridden once on the school site. The children have been told this in assembly and were also reminded about riding appropriately outside of the school gates. After half term the new infant bike/scooter shed will be ready, this is located near the Wisps garden and can be accessed by following the signs that Mr Meredith will be putting up.

Meal prices- Unfortunately these have risen and the cost of a meal will be £3 after half term. This meal increase has come from Hampshire caterers and is beyond our control. We do hate chasing parents for dinner money but as I'm sure you can appreciate, budgets are so tight we do not have the capacity to cover debt as we are charged by Hampshire for the meals taken.

Sports Day- Sports day will be held on 7th July with the juniors in the morning and the infants in the afternoon. Parents are invited to both events but will need to leave site between the two events. Mrs Mathlin and Miss Walker will be at a conference for the day, Miss King and Mrs Bailey will be in charge if you have any concerns or worries during the event.
