A few reminders for the start of term on Monday 5th September (Thursday1st and Friday 2nd are inset days) :

Start times:

Infants: Doors open at 8.40am and close at 8.55am.

Juniors: Doors open at 8.35am and close at 8.45am.

Anyone arriving after these times must go to the admin office based in the junior school.

Entry points:

Infant children all go in through their outside classroom door.

Year 3 go down the side path round to the back of the school and in through their outside classroom door.

Year 4 and 5 go down the side path and in through the side door.

Year 6 go down the side path, round the back of the school and in through the doors at the bottom of the stairs.

Please note on the first day of term junior teachers (Years 4-6) will meet their classes in the playground and show them the route they need to take.

Year 3 children will meet their new teacher in the hall.

Finish times:

Finish time is 3pm for all classes.

Infant and Year 3 to be collected from classroom doors. Infant children must be collected by an adult.

Years 4-6 to be collected from the junior playground.
