### Hampshire KS2 Philharmonia – Orchestra Unwrapped The Anvil, Basingstoke, Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2025 – Year 5

Dear Parents,

We have been very fortunate in being able to secure tickets for the above event to be held on **Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> March**. Children will be walking to/from the Anvil theatre to this live music event.

The theme for the 2024/25 *Orchestra Unwrapped* concerts is *Nordic Nature and its Magical Lands*. Join us on an epic adventure as we embark on a musical journey through the stunning landscapes of the Nordic region. We'll explore oceans, forests and mountains through the works of prominent Nordic composers such as Grieg and Sibelius and discover ways we can help protect and preserve the natural world. The concert has been devised especially for Key Stage 2 pupils and is suitable for all children.

The concert starts at 1pm and due to the timing, children will leave school at 12.10pm and will have an early lunch time to accommodate this. Please provide a packed lunch for your child as school dinners will not be available. If your child is entitled to free school meals, a school packed lunch can be pre-ordered via the form attached.

The concert running time is 70 mins approx. and children should be back in school for normal pick-up time of 3.15pm.

The cost of the trip is £4.50 per child and the deadline for payments is **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> March**.
