Dear Parents,

We are pleased to be able to confirm the following trips for our Year 6 activities:

- 10th June 2025 - New Forest Activities. The children will be taking part in two activities (Canoeing and Battlezone) <https://newforestactivities.co.uk>
- 11th June 2025 - Paultons Park, <https://paultonspark.co.uk/>

Please note, these are not curriculum enhancement trips and all costs for children are to be met by parents.

In the New Forest, children will spend 2 hours on the Beaulieu River with fully qualified instructors as well as several members of staff to ensure all can have fun and stay safe. It is a beautiful location and the canoes are stable and will take up to 4 people. The second session, is even more energetic as children will work teams competing against each other. Teamwork and resilience are the key to success across this day.

At Paulton's Park, we arrive for the start of the day at 10am to maximise our time for fun. By the time we leave, at 2pm, most children will have been on most rides on several (or more) occasions. Because we are going in term time, the park is very quiet and we can usually ride, run around and ride again! For those who like a quieter time, we will make sure you are grouped with other similar minded children so you can enjoy the gardens, birds and animals (and some rides if you like).

The total for two trips is approx. £80.00 (depending on final numbers). This includes all travel, entrance and activities. The cost breakdown is as follows:

£56 New forest activity centre, this is £40 for the activities and £16 coach costs.

£24 Paultons Park, this is £14 park admission and £10 coach costs.

We will provide a more detailed letter outlining travel times, dress code etc. at a later date. Please complete the permission slip below if your child would like to attend. Once you have signed up to the trips, you are committing to paying the full amount unless there are extenuating circumstances for non-attendance which must be discussed with myself. Payment can be made in full or in instalments by cash into the Admin office or online through Arbor. **All payments must be received in full by Friday 16th May.**

To help us organise these events, please return the form below by **MONDAY 3rd February 2025** indicating if you are happy for your child to come on these trips. If you would like to discuss financial arrangements, please contact Admin office or myself. If you decide that you do not want your child to take part, then they will have provision made for them in school on those days.

If your child is unsure about the content of trips, they are more than welcome to speak to current Year 6 staff who attended the trips last year and had a wonderful time!

We look forward to a fantastic selection of activities that we know your child will enjoy and benefit from.
