Taskmaster	Monday 3:15-4:15 Junior hall (to 23 <sup>rd</sup> Jun)	3-6	£30 for 6 weeks	In Taskmaster Club, the children are the contestants, whilst the adult takes on the role of the Taskmaster, ably assisted by Little Alex Horne himself. Each session includes 4 tasks to develop children's problem-solving and reasoning skills, as well as building teamwork, creativity, and resilience. Arts & Crafts	Tuesday 3:15-4:15 Kingfisher	R-3	£45 for 10 weeks	Various arts and crafts activities some of which your child will bring home. Open to Year R this term but maximum numbers still apply. With Mrs Hurst, Mrs Nelson-Williams and Mrs Brown.
Stage Club	Thursday 3:15-4:15 Junior hall	1-6	£45 for 10 weeks	Fun activities encompassing acting, singing and dancing, aimed at building resilience and teamwork. With Miss Arnold and other support staff.
Hockey	Thursday 3:15-4:15 Field or Playground	1-6	£45.00 for 10 weeks	The best way to introduce Hockey to children is by playing Quicksticks. It is 4-a-side, can be played on any surface, and uses a larger, lighter and safer ball. It is a fun, fast, safe and exciting game. Balls and sticks will be provided by the school. With Mrs Branch and Miss Graydon.
