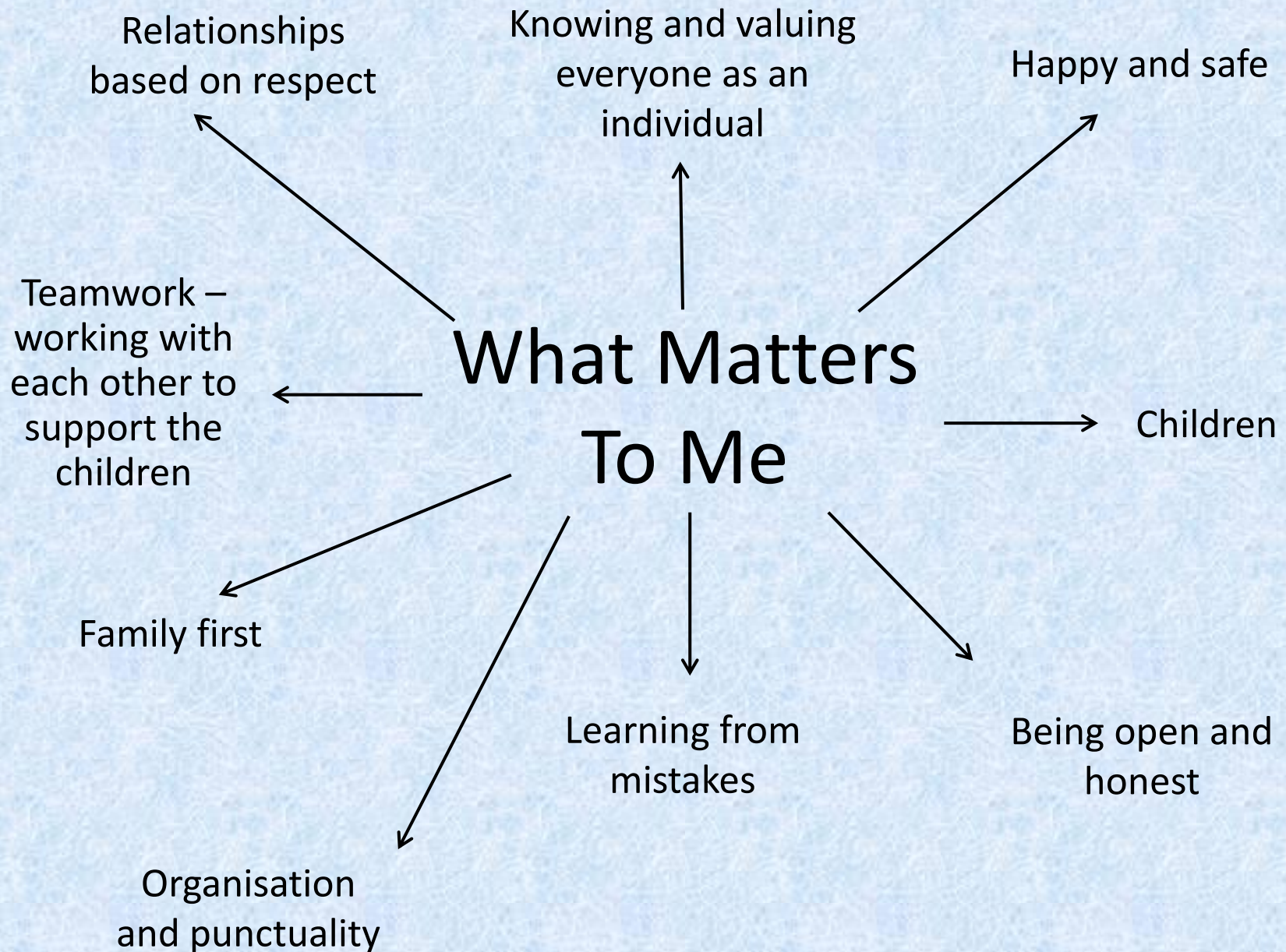

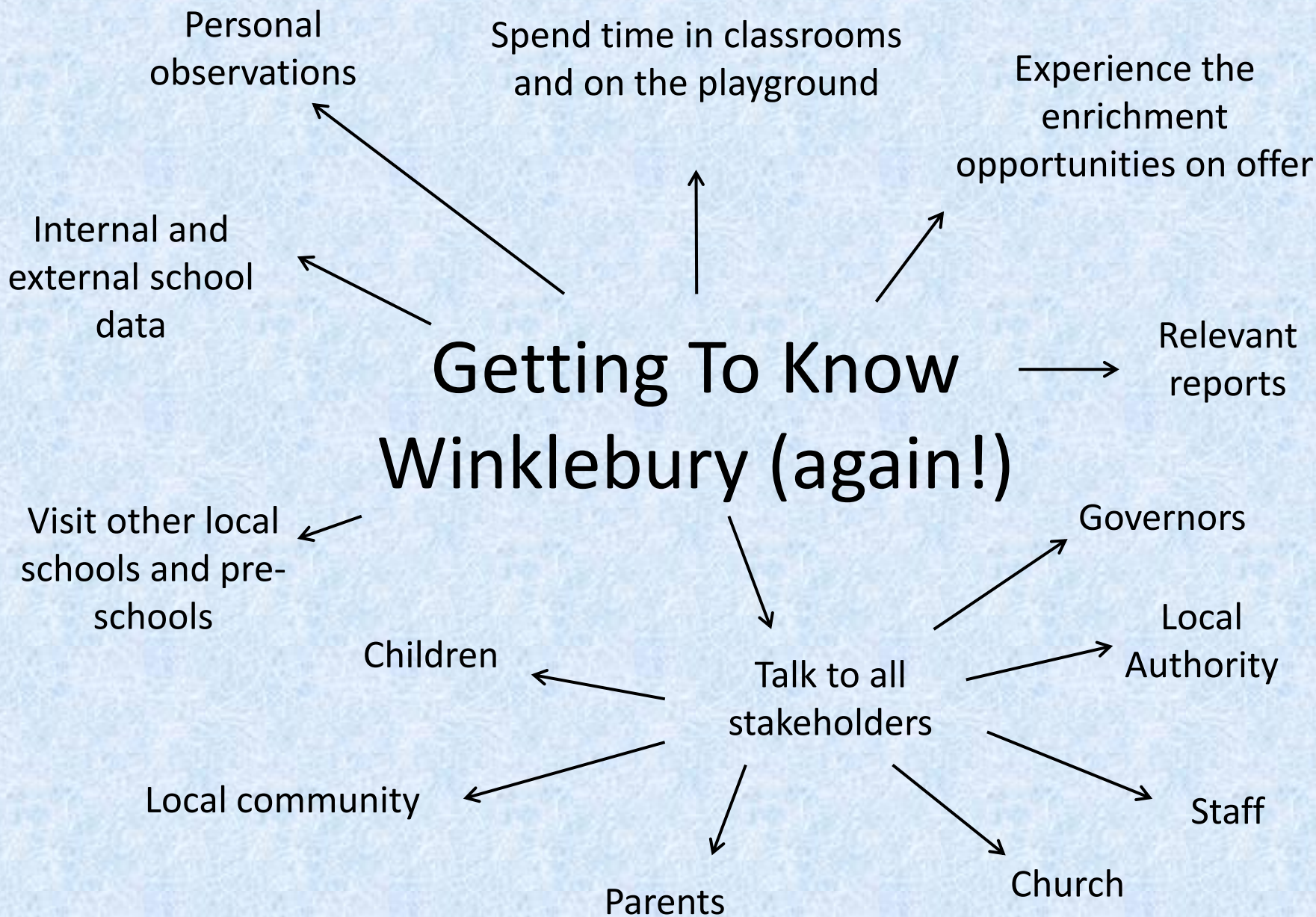
My Vision
