

HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

We recognise that the education of your child is a venture shared by yourselves as parents, school staff and governors and the child themselves. We all have an important part to play in ensuring your child enjoys their time at school and achieves all they are capable of.

The Home:School Agreement details the contributions we must all make to ensure our partnership is successful for your child.

As a school we will:

- * promote a culture of achievement by celebrating the personal, social and academic success of your child;
- * value your child as an individual;
- * treat your child and your family with respect and sensitivity;
- * provide a learning environment that is safe, caring and attractive;
- * provide you with regular information about your child's progress, attainment and achievements and contact you if we have concerns about any of these;
- * welcome you into the life of the school and offer opportunities to involve you in your child's education;
- * contact you if concerns arise regarding any aspect of your child's well-being, including attendance and punctuality;
- * provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child and includes a range of enrichment activities.

As a parent I will:

- * ensure my child attends school regularly and, if my child is absent, provide a reason for non-attendance on the morning of the first day of absence;
- * ensure my child arrives promptly at the start of the school day;
- * ensure my child is collected promptly at the end of the school day;
- * attend opportunities offered by the school to discuss my child's progress, attainment and achievements;
- * take an interest in, and support, my child's learning including supporting my child with homework;
- * support the school's Behaviour Policy and work with the school to ensure my child behaves appropriately;
- * ensure my child wears school uniform as outlined in the school's Uniform Policy;
- * contact the school if concerns arise about my child's progress, behaviour or well-being.

As a child I will:

- * work hard at school;
- * care for and value myself, others and the school environment;
- * behave appropriately;
- * be polite and show respect to everyone in school;
- * try not to be absent from school;
- * try to always be on time for school;
- * try to enjoy school, make my learning fun and help others to do the same;
- * wear my school uniform smartly and with pride;
- * talk to an adult if I am unhappy or need help.
