We will have a poetry focus beginning with the book 'Lost Words'.

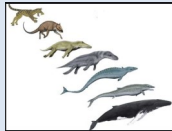


Geography

We are exploring life cycles, evolution and natural selection.



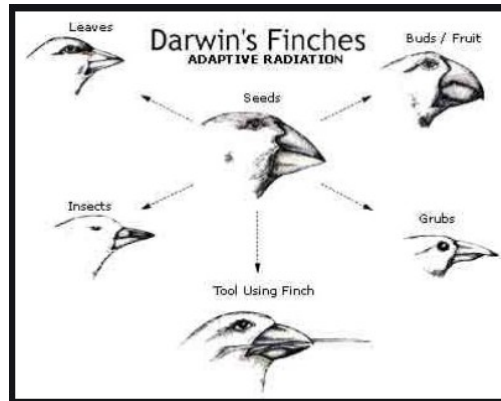

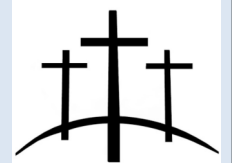
Art
