

Mathematics



In Maths we will continue to build on our understanding of measures including telling the time from an analogue clock and finding and comparing weights. We will be learning to add and subtract amounts of money in practical contexts. We will also continue to develop our understanding of number and place value focusing on reading and writing numbers up to 1000 in numerals and words. We ask that your child continues to practise their x's tables by practising the x2, x5, x10, x3, x4 and x8 which is the expectation for the end of Year 3. If you have any problems logging into Times Table Rock stars please see your child's class teacher.



French

In French we will be learning to play simple French games as well as sing simple French songs. We will continue to develop our French vocabulary by recapping French numbers and colours.




History




R.E

Science

In Science we will be looking at solids, liquids and gases and exploring how some materials can change into these different states. We will be creating our own investigations and carrying them out. You could even start making a list of all the ones you can think about at home!



English

In reading we will be looking at a non-fiction text called Stone Age: Hunters, Gatherers and Woolly Mammoths. We will be revisiting what we know about non-fiction as well as continuing to build reading skills of fluency, expression and inference. In writing we will be using the text "Stone Age boy" by Satoshi Kitamura. We will be writing to Mr. Kitamura using persuasive language and making sure we continue to build on the new skills we have been learning so far.



Art and DT

In art this term, we will be looking at cave paintings from the Stone Age era. We will be using these to create our own drawings inspired by these cave dwellers. In addition to this, we will be practising our sewing skills by creating a new pair of trousers for one of the characters in our book.

Music



We will be continuing to learn simple notation as well as other key music skills such as pitch, rhythm and tempo. We will be focusing on our listening skills by finding and moving to the pulse as well as identifying the style of the music.



PDL

In PDL we will be talking about the different types of families and relationships that we have. We will be discussing bullying and considering the effects and consequences for the people involved. We will also consider how this can also happen online.

Computing



In computing we will be using Microsoft PowerPoint to create a presentation about the Stone Age. We will learn to add media, use animations and add timings to create a slideshow.
