

English

Our writing will be based around the book 'The Jamie Drake Equation' by Christopher Edge. We will be looking at character and speech and practising our narrative writing skills. In reading we will be looking at the non-fiction book "Dr Maggie's Grand Tour of the Solar System," by Dr Maggie Aderin-Pocock. We will look at audience, form and layout as well as practising our retrieval and inference skills.

Science



We will be exploring space in science this term: investigating Earth's place in the solar system, what stars and other objects are as well as the effect of gravity.

Hook

Explore the universe and the planets in our solar system virtually.

Outcome

Gallery of work within school, to share with another class.

Maths



We will start the term with a focus on statistics. We will be using formal written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and applying these skills to problem solving. We will be recapping multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. To finish there will be a geometry focus on using coordinates.

Geography

We will be completing a local study using fieldwork to observe, measure, record and present the human and physical features in the local area. We will also look at using map symbols and grid references.

In PDL, we will explore the theme of Health & Wellbeing. Starting with healthy sleep habits, sun safety, immunisations and allergies.



French

We will be learning the French names for the planets and then using these to create short sentences.

Computing

During computing this term, we will be extending our knowledge of coding using Scratch. We will be creating our own space themed games.

We will be learning new sewing skills this term as we create space themed cushions with applique decorations.

We will be listening to pieces of space related music and thinking about how composers create mood, effect and atmosphere.
