

Mathematics



In Maths, we will continue to build on our understanding of measures including telling the time from an analogue clock and finding and comparing weights. We will be learning to add and subtract amounts of money in practical contexts. We will also continue to develop our understanding of number and place value focusing on reading and writing numbers up to 1000 in numerals and words. We ask that your child continues to practise their x's tables by practising the x2, x5, x10, x3, x4 and x8 which is the expectation for the end of Year 3.



French

In French, we will be learning to play simple French games as well as learning to sing simple French songs. We will continue to develop our French vocabulary by recapping French numbers and colours.



History



In History, we will be travelling back in time to the Stone Age where we will be finding out what life was like for people during this period. We will then move forward into the Iron Age and then finally onto Bronze Age and looking at the impact these had on our current modern day life.

P.E.



We will have two sessions of P.E per week. One of which will be gymnastics and the other will be keurling. We will continue to have regular active breaks throughout the day so please make sure you bring in a coat so we can continue to practise our golden mile.



R.E

We will be looking at the theme of "authority" and exploring what that means for us in different places. We will also be learning about the "Torah" and how this is important to Judaism.

Science

In Science, we will be continuing to investigate solids, liquids and gases but will also start our new topic on skeletons. We will be thinking about how our skeletons support our bodies as well as understand what an exoskeleton is.



PSHE

In PSHE, we will be talking about the different types of families and relationships that we have. We will be discussing bullying and considering the effects and consequences for the people involved. We will also consider how this can also happen online.

Computing

In computing, we will be using Microsoft PowerPoint to create a presentation about the Stone Age. We will learn to add media use animations and add timings to create a slideshow.



English

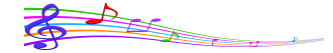
