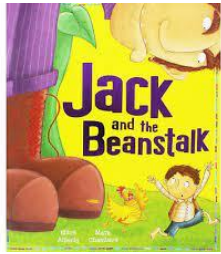


In **English** we will be adapting the traditional tale 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and will be creating ideas of what could be at the top of the beanstalk. We will be writing sentences ensuring we have a capital letter, finger spaces, used our phonics and have a full stop at the end of the sentence. We will be learning how to use 'and' to join words. We will be beginning to look at nouns and adjectives to create exciting noun phrases.

The children will continue to follow a daily phonics programme from 'Little Wandle'.



In **Geography** we will be naming, locating and identifying characteristics of the 4 countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas. We will be focusing on London and the landmarks of London.

In **Art** we will be focusing on the artist Andy Goldsworthy. We will be experimenting with pastels and paint to make shades and tones of green. Then the children will create natural sculptures using materials found outside.



In **Computing** we are going to be introduced to 'Scratch' and will be creating algorithms to move and travel.



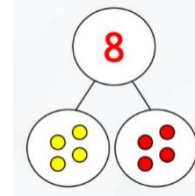
In **R.E.** we are focusing on the word 'remembering' and will be describing ways in which Jews remember the Passover story. We will be discussing how remembering makes us feel and link this to our own experience of a special meal at home.

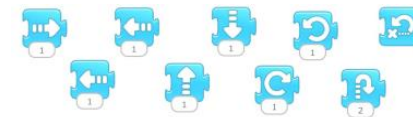
'Once upon a time'

In **Maths** the children will continue to count in 1s to 100, 2s to 20 and 10s to 100. Please continue to practice counting back from 50 to 0. We will continue to partition numbers up to 20 using a part part whole model, tens frame, bar model and solve problems using concrete resources. We will also be learning how to tell the time to the hour and half past the hour. Please continue to practice the number bonds to 5 and 10.



In **P.S.H.E.** we will be looking at living in the wider world. We will be discussing how we care for people, animals and other living things in different ways, different jobs and discussing why people use the internet.

In **Design and Technology** we will be creating a hand puppet using different joining techniques. The children will be designing their own fairy tale character and then join the fabric together.
