

Mathematics



In Maths this term we will be revising everything we have learnt so far this year. We will continue to build on skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication, division as well as time, capacity, weight, shape and measure. We ask that your child continues to practise their x's tables by practising the x2, x5, x10, x3, x4 and x8 which is the expectation for the end of Year 3. We will also be looking at money, so it would be helpful if you could look at coins with your child as well as making sure they can pay for items within £1. Any opportunity for your child to experience paying for items first hand would be appreciated.

English



In reading, we will be looking at the text "The Velveteen rabbit" by Margery Williams. We will continue to focus on the meaning of unusual words to help make sense of the story as well as answer questions and use the text to justify our answers. In writing, we will be looking at the text "Paddington at the Palace" by Michael Bond. We will be writing our own adventure story as well as writing a newspaper report about Paddington bear and remembering her late majesty the Queen.



French

In French, we will be learning about Portraits and naming different parts of the face. We will be making our own monster faces and continuing to practise learning numbers and colours in French.



Art

In art this term, we will be looking at the contemporary artist Jennie Maizels, who has illustrated her own book called "Pop up London." In response to Jennie's work, we will create our own London landmarks using the skill of printmaking as well as having a go at creating some digital art.



Geography

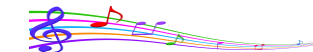
