

## Mathematics



In Maths this term, we will be continuing to practise our times tables and division facts for the X3, X4 and X8. We will be consolidating everything we have learnt so far this year, including time, money and fractions. We will also be learning the column method for addition and subtraction when exchanging and making sure that we are secure with place value using numbers within 1000. As always, please continue to practise your times tables and division facts as these are fundamental to having a secure grasp of mathematics as they move further up the school.



## French

In French, we will be learning about the language of friendship by reading and understanding the story - The four friends ( Les quatre amis) We will also continue to practise speaking in French using verbs and questions.

## History



In History, we will be learning all about the Egyptians and thinking about what life was like during this time. We will be analysing information and justifying reasons as to why sources might not always be as reliable as we think. We will also be having a visitor from Portals of the Past to explore everything Egyptian!



## P.E.

We will continue to have two sessions of P.E per week (Football and rounders). ## Science

In Science, we will be learning about Rocks and Soils. We will be thinking about what our Planet Earth is made from and investigating the different rocks we have, using the key words of sedimentary, igneous and volcanic rocks.

## English



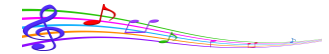
