

English

Both reading and writing will be based around our Ancient Greek theme. In writing we will be starting with writing a character description on a new Greek God which they will create.

Then we will be studying Greek Myths to create a setting description using atmosphere.

In reading we will be looking at a range of Greek myths and legends and also the poem 'The Pobble who had no toes'. Our focus will be to consolidate the skills practised this year.

Science



The children will learn about the parts of the circulatory system including the importance of the heart and lungs. They will look at the role of the heart and lungs in maintaining good health.

Maths



We will start the term looking at Roman Numerals and then going onto problem solving and reasoning using the four calculations. For the remainder of the half-term we will be revising the areas of maths we have already looked at throughout the year and the children will be applying the skills and knowledge they have learnt to problem solving and reasoning activities.

History

This half-term our theme is all about the Ancient Greeks. We will be learning about what life was like in Ancient Greek times and also the legacies and achievements of the Ancient Greeks and how they are part of our modern society.

We will continue our focus on health and well-being, looking at mental wellbeing and keeping safe in different situations. We will also be looking at puberty and how the body changes.
