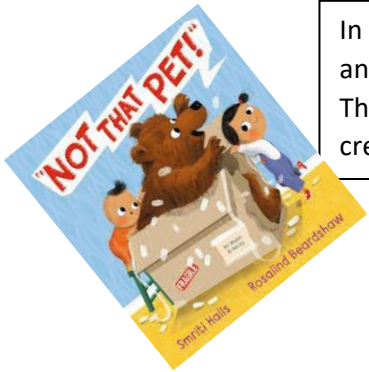

In **Art**, the children will be creating their own portraits. They will be developing their skills of drawing recognisable facial features using pencils.

How you can help?

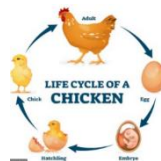
Reading. PLEASE practice as often as possible. DON'T FORGET OUR CLASS READING RACE! There are Keywords to practice also.

In **History**, the children will be learning about Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole and comparing how their lives were similar and different. We will discuss and think about who has had the most significant impact on our lives today.



In **PSHE**, the children will be starting their journals for "My Happy Mind" which introduces them to "Meet my brain."

In **Science** the children will be investigating animal and human life cycles and food chains. We will be creating our own habitats as well as thinking about which habitat is best suited for each animal.



In **Maths**, the children will be working on their number skills, counting to 100 in steps of 1, 2 and 10 as well as revising their number bonds to 10 and 20. We will also be partitioning numbers into tens and ones as part of place value. Additionally, we will be finding one more and one less than a number. We will also be measuring and estimating length, height and mass.
